



How to get here:



BY CAR: Oban Airport is situated just off the A828 by the village of North Connel and some six miles from the centre of Oban. Take the A82, A85, and cross Connel Bridge heading to Fort William.



BY TRAIN: Scotrail operate return services between Glasgow Queen Street and Oban. Disembark the train at Connel Ferry for Oban Airport.



BY BUS: West Coast Motors operate a regular service via the airport. Service No 405 and 005.



BY BICYCLE: Oban Airport is easily accessed from National Cycle Route 78 which conveniently passes the main terminal building.

What will I find at the Airport?

Although Oban is a vital connecting point for the Island communities, you won't find crowds and chaos. Instead there's an amazing view, friendly staff and a peaceful atmosphere. You can enjoy a coffee in our refreshment area, arrange bike hire with one of our friendly team or make use of the free Wi-Fi.

The Airport is fully accessible and there is free car parking for all visitors.

When can I fly and where can I go?

Hebridean Air Services offer regular scheduled flights to Coll and Tiree on Mondays and Wednesdays, and Islay and Colonsay on Tuesdays and Thursdays. There are also flights to Coll and Colonsay on Fridays and Sundays during school term time.

You can book a same day return and enjoy a great day out exploring any of these tranquil islands. It's also possible, for a nominal charge, to take bikes, golf clubs and surfboards with you in addition to your 10kg baggage allowance. Pets are also welcome on board, but please advise the airline before you travel.
